We know you will do really well in Year 2.






YEAR 2 - Oak

It has been a pleasure to teach all the children in Oak Class, we are so proud of them all!







Celebration Assemblies...

Please be reminded that we will be holding our Year 2 leavers assembly on **Tuesday 22nd July at 9:15am** and parents / carers are invited.



School Lunches...

Children return to school on Tuesday 2nd September. Please make sure you have ordered your child a lunch for the first week back to school through WisePay. The deadline for ordering is Wednesday 20th August. Ideally, please book your child a lunch for the first term.

UNIVERSAL INFANT FREE SCHOOL MEALS:

Did you know that all children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 receive FREE school meals through the Government incentive, Universal Infant Free School Meals.

Your child can choose from a range of delicious hot and cold options including; vegetable curry, fish fingers, macaroni cheese, pesto pasta, chicken noodles, jacket potato with cheese and beans, cheese roll.

From September St Pauls Catholic School meals will be offering a packed lunch option where parents can order a choice of ham or cheese sandwich instead of a hot meal. The packed lunch includes a sandwich, yoghurt, piece of fruit, a snack and a drink.

Meal choices are ordered on a 3 week rotation.



FREE SCHOOL MEALS - ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?:

If you earn under a certain threshold amount or are in receipt of certain benefits, you could be entitled to Free School Meals/Pupil Premium.

Briefly including:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
