Thank you again for all your support and hard work over the year. We hope everyone has a fantastic summer!



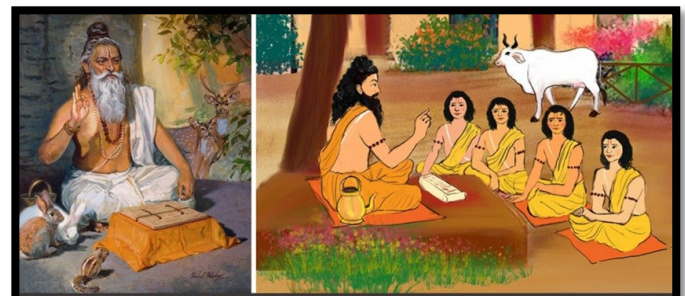
YEAR 1 - Maple

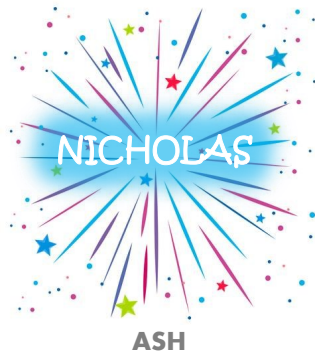

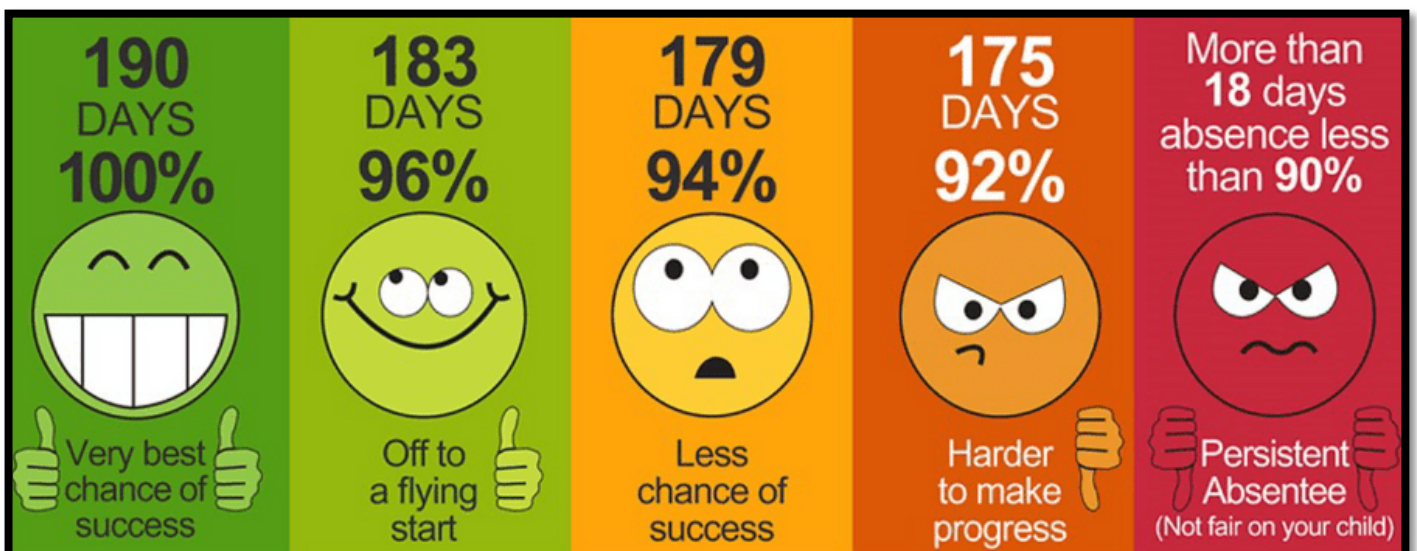
